

## **ILLNESS POLICY**

If you know your camper is ill and you make the responsible decision to keep them home, simply provide a doctor's note within 5 days of their scheduled session, and we will be happy to refund your camp fees, minus the non-refundable deposit, specialty camp, and/or bus fees, if applicable.

If at any time your camper shows symptoms of illness (symptoms include, but are not limited to, vomiting, diarrhea, conjunctivitis, sore throat, and other signs of a potential communicable disease), with or without a temperature of 100.4<sup>o</sup>, you will have the following options:

You can pick your camper up and take them to the doctor for diagnosis/treatment. Your camper may return to camp after any required treatment, with a doctor's note.

We can take your camper to the doctor for diagnosis/treatment. If your camper requires treatment, including fever reducers, they will need to be picked up from camp. Your camper may return to camp after any required treatment, with a doctor's note.

You can pick your camper up and take them home.

No refund will be issued to campers that leave camp to receive treatment.

If symptoms return after the doctor has cleared the camper to return, they will be sent home, and no refund will be issued.

## **INJURY POLICY**

If your camper sustains an injury prior to their arrival at camp, please provide a doctor's note clearing them to participate in camp activities, including any limitations that they may have. If your camper is injured, it is best to call the office prior to check-in to make sure your camper will have a successful camp experience.

If your camper sustains an injury while at camp and it is determined they need treatment, we will need to receive a doctor's note allowing them to return to camp and participate in camp activities, including any limitations that they may have.
